The Student Orientation Course consists of sections, each with its own introduction and thematic learning units. Within each of the thematic learning units listed below there is an introduction, information on how to access and use the tool/feature, best practices, a “try it yourself” activity (when appropriate), and conclusion.

- **Introduction:** Comprises of a welcome, a course legend, hardware and software requirements, and browser plug-ins.
- **Finding Your Way:** Contains information on accessing Blackboard, personalizing a tab, navigating a course environment, using Review Status and Adaptive Release, and a learning tools overview.
- **Learning Online:** Introduces online learning and tips for success, as well as provides a self-assessment on readiness for learning online.
- **Getting Organized:** Incorporates use of Personal Information, the Calendar, and Tasks.
- **Interacting Online:** Reviews viewing Announcements, using Email and Messages, participating in Discussion Boards and the Virtual Classroom, and collecting and sharing links with Scholar®.
- **Submitting Work:** Covers completing an Assignment (including SafeAssign®), reviewing classmates’ work with Peer Assessment, and checking progress with My Grades.
- **Taking Tests:** Consists of information on how to complete a test, fill out a survey, and review results; and includes a real practice test on the course content.
- **How to Get Help:** Introduces the Blackboard User Manual, Behind the Blackboard™, and Ask Dr. C.
- **Course Evaluation:** Contains a survey for students to complete about the course experience.
